As noted in our Handbook, students may transfer in up to 9 hours of credit. See p. 17, Section D: "Transfer of Credits "No more than 9 hours of transfer credit will be accepted toward the master's degree. The written confirmation of courses accepted for transfer will be placed in the student's academic folder after acceptance by the Counseling committee." Because 9 credits is less than one semester, students transferring in generally do not graduate significantly earlier, but rather, are typically able to take more specialized courses and complete additional clinical work.
